ROOKIE'S INITIATION



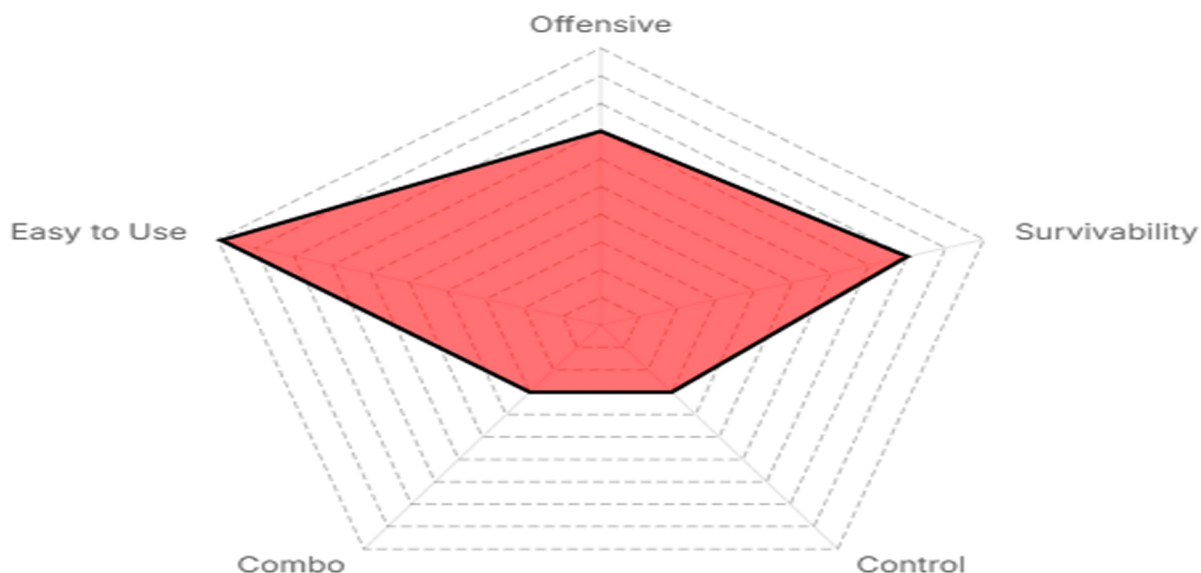
**Gaia's deck is one of the two starter decks.

NEOPHYTE TRAINING



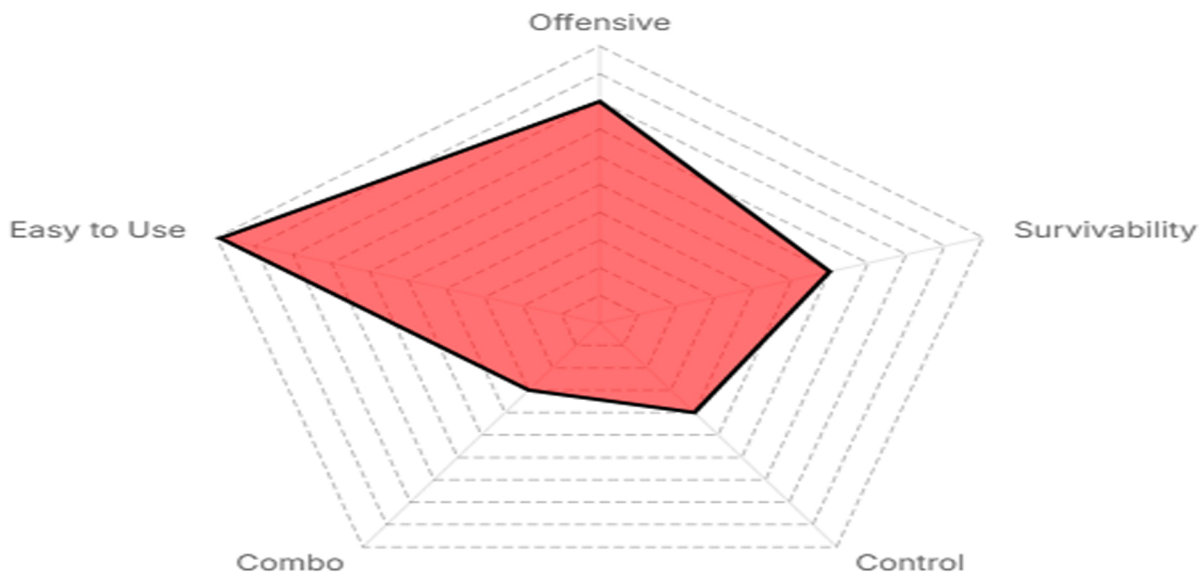
Caelum's deck is one of the two starter decks. It is able to deal more DMG than the other deck.

The most feared and hated Numen; His intentions are easy to misunderstand and his actions seem cruel and unjustified. Many have tried to destroy him, but none will ever succeed, for hatred of him only increases his force. Even death will not free his victims from his grip. Those who accept him gain great strength from him.

Övdölt's deck can deal instant defeat DMG by buffing his team and well planned strikes.

Pros:

High Skill DMG dealing, can DMG multiple enemies and easily buff allies.

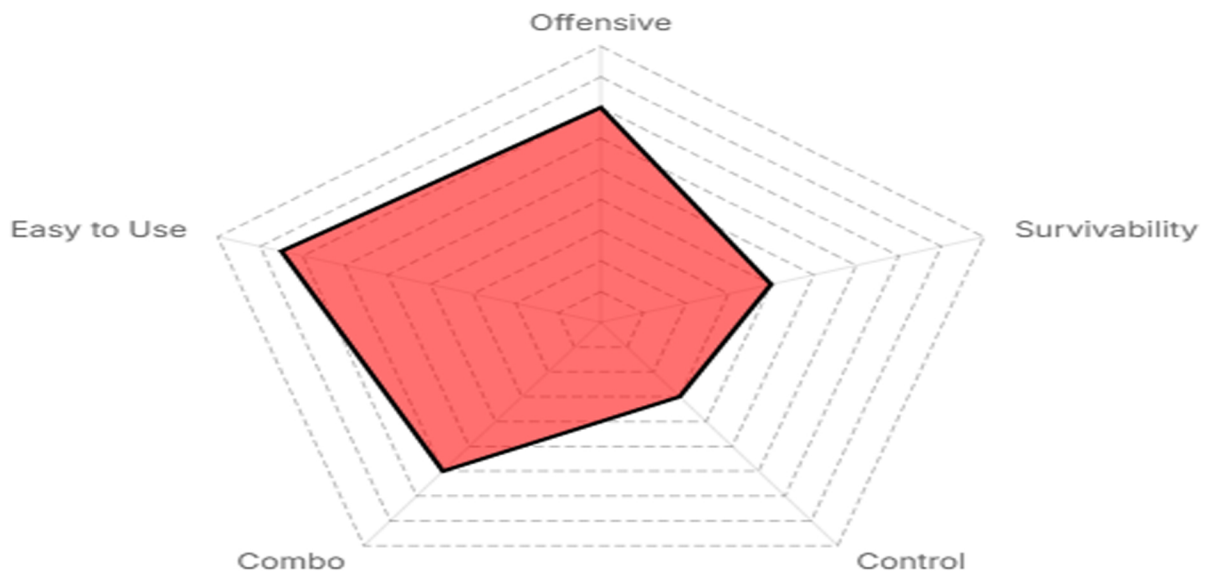
Cons:

High AP cost for combos and allies are easy to defeat.

Tips:

Focus on keeping Gecko undefeated and buffing him so he can deal additional big DMG to the enemies.

BRUTE FORCE

Dýnami the Exponential Bulk



Numen of Strength

In his mortal life, he gained incomparable strength through his surhuman training and many fights to prove his dominance. He used to be really violent but since his awakening as a Numen he started being interested in other things than just brutal display of power and has helped many to become stronger.

Dýnami's deck focuses on hit DMG with high ATK Fighters and Aura enhancements.

Pros:

Multiple hit attacks are easy to perform with this deck and can quickly defeat the enemies.

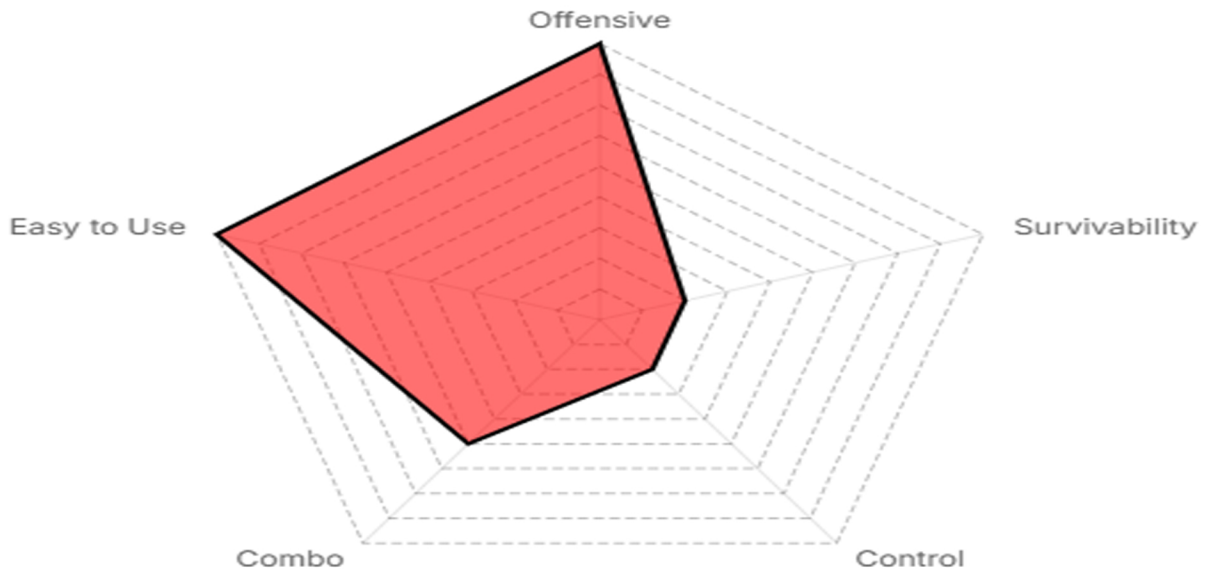
Cons:

Lacks defensive options and survivability. Can sometimes be easily countered.

Tips:

Floon & Leia are valuable Fighters try to keep them undefeated and only deploy them when it's safe.

02 - OFFENSIVE DECK



Win Rate: 51%

MUSIC FESTIVAL



Etna's deck focuses on board positions, pushes and Tiles.

Pros:

Great control on Fighters' position and can deal huge DMG by setting Tiles combos.

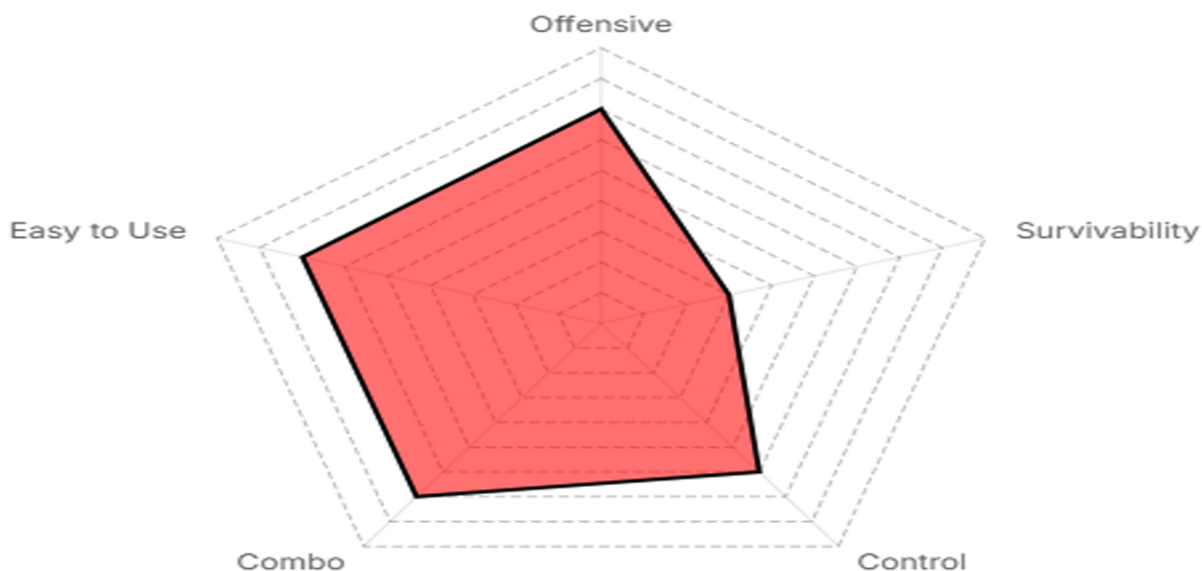
Cons:

Allies lack survivability and the opponent can easily destroy all Tiles.

Tips:

Prioritize having Hu, Dance Pad, Dance Floor and Funguy & Fungal in play to maximize your DMG potential and setups.

03 - TILES DECK



Win Rate: 59%

STRATEGIC MEDIC



Amanzi's deck focuses on negating effects and healings. The healings can be used to reduce HP.

Pros:

Can reduce HP regardless of Resistances & Protection and can negate effects by recycling Trigger Powers.

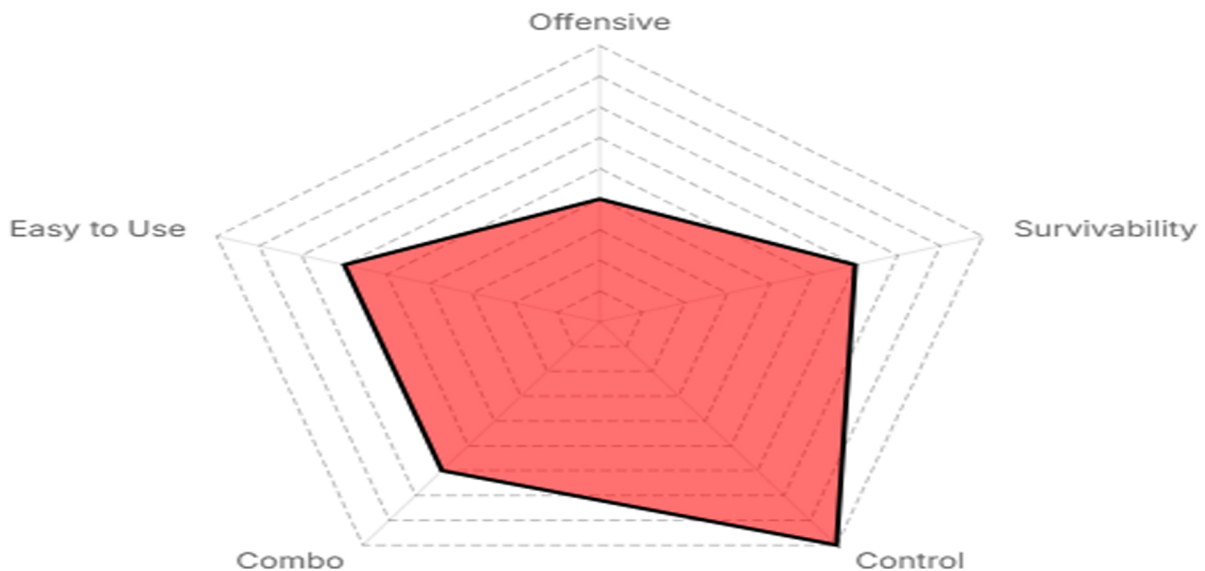
Cons:

High AP cost combos and lacks offensive strength if the main combos enabling allies are defeated.

Tips:

Focus on managing your AP and surviving until you can defeat as many fighters as possible at once.

04 - NEGATE & HEALS DECK

IMPREGNABLE DEFENSE



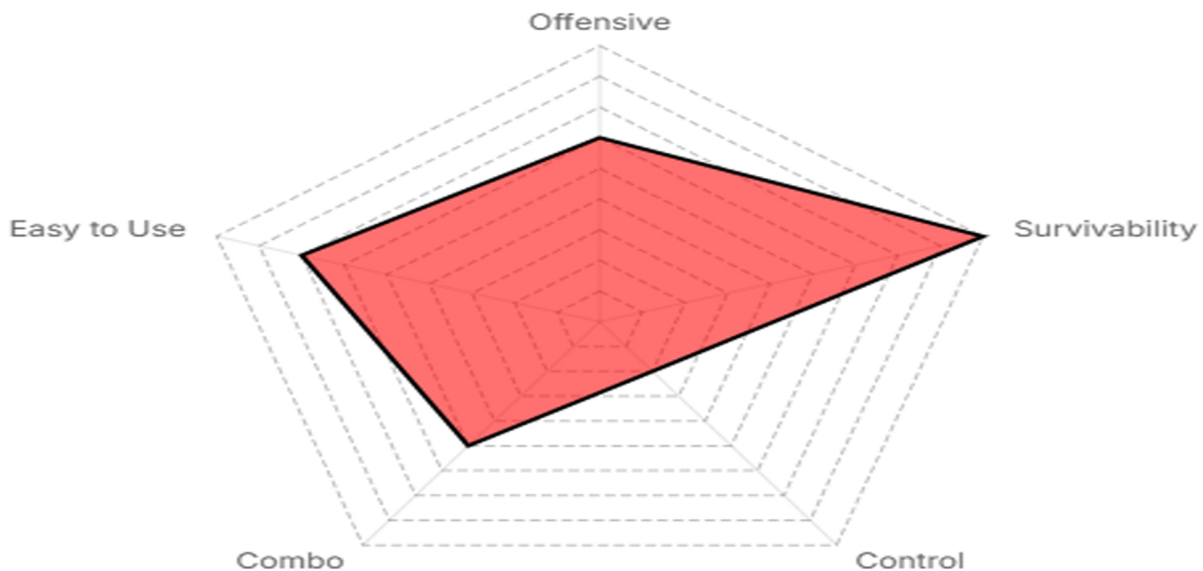
Tutela's deck goal is to build an invincible team that can use DEF instead of ATK to hit enemies.

Pros:
Outstanding DEF and survivability by giving Protection to allies.

Cons:
Most allies have low Speed & MP and requires a lot of AP to deal consistent DMG.

Tips:
Focus on keeping Agor undefeated and use your AP wisely.

05 - DEFENSIVE DECK

Al-Kimīā the Psychedelic Transmutation

When a Status is applied:
You gain 1 AP
(Once per turn)

Conjuration

Discard 1 Power in your

In the beginning there was neither existence nor non-existence, all was unmanifested energy. Until a powerful desire emerged within the infinite void, since then nothing was ever the same. Nothing became something, then everything. In constant flux the world gradually became as it is through Al-Kimīā's alterations.

Al-Kimīā's deck uses a combination of Statuses & Debuff to defeat the enemies.

Pros:

With the right setup it can defeat enemies when their turn starts.

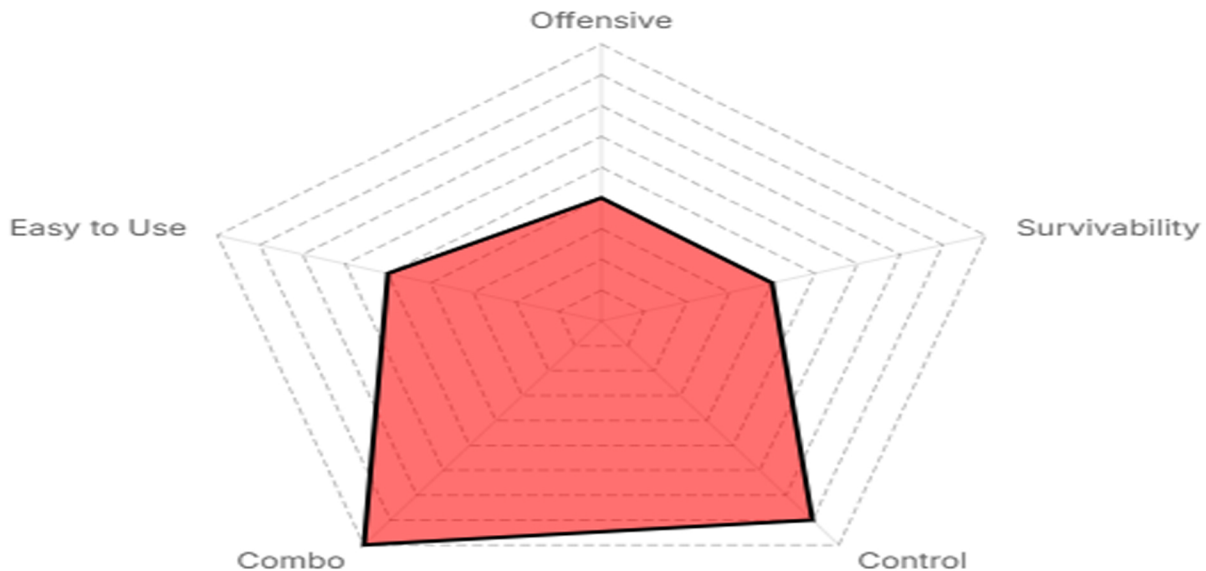
Cons:

Requires AP & ULTIMATE management and needs 4 deployed enemies for maximum efficiency.

Tips:

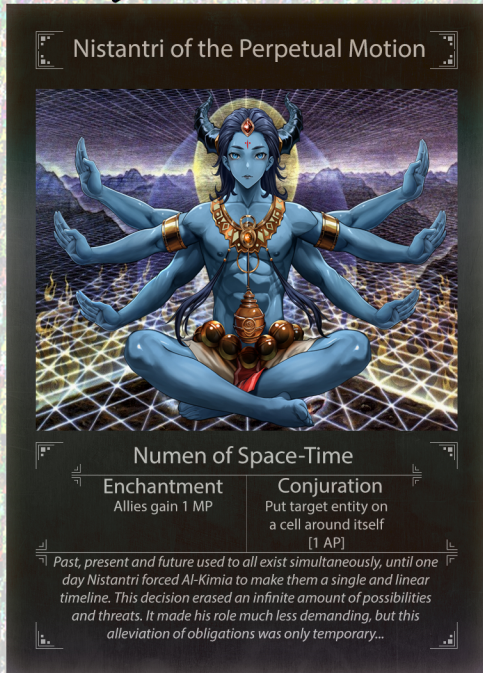
Try to get Taunt, Qual, Unleash, Contagious and Recycle during Setup Phase to be able to setup your combos early and put the opponent at disadvantage.

06 - STATUS DECK



Win Rate: 48%

DREAM TEAM



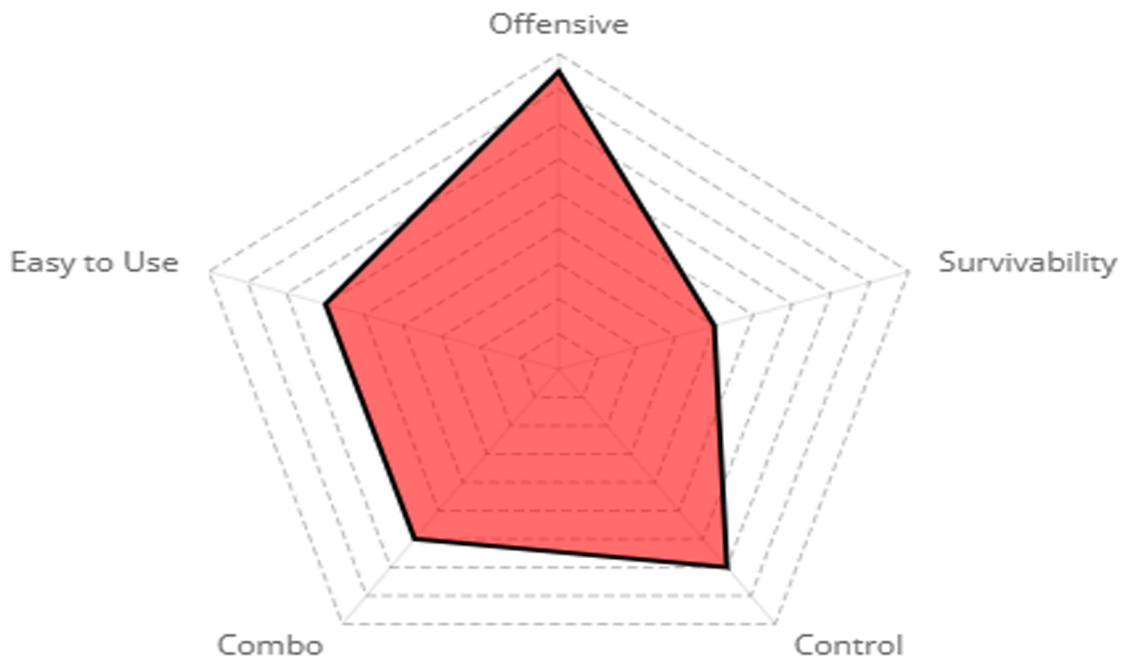
Nistantri's deck uses a combination of team work, Use-Based effects and board positioning.

Pros:
Great synergies among allies and with the right setup it can use Skills and Powers for free.

Cons:
Low survivability and heavily relies on two specific allies for its offensive strength.

Tips:
Focus on having Mathemagic and Gratuitous Prowesses to be able to use Powers & Skills for free.

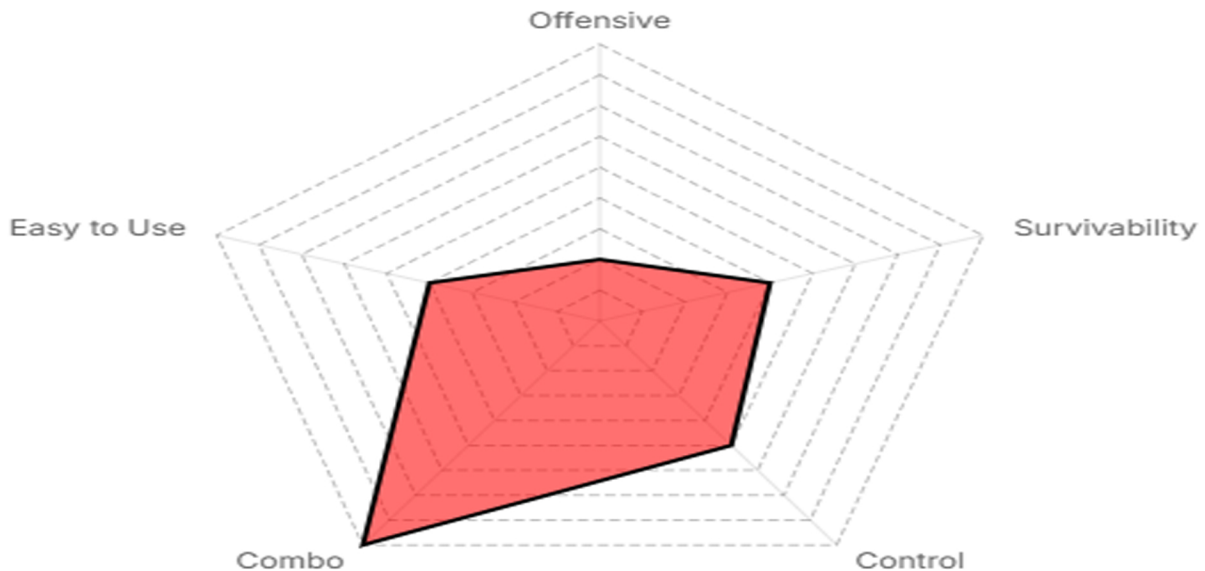
Procyon's deck deploys many Summons to deal combo DMG with them and his team.

Pros:
Overwhelming Summons deployment and deals a lot of Power DMG.

Cons:
Lacks offensive strength and relies heavily on its Summons for combos.

Tips:
Deploy Fuq Yew and use Silhouette of Anguish to increase all your Summons DMG. Let your Summons do the fighting for you with Viri passive.
